Royal Decree No. 9/2022 4th April 2022

Royal Decree No. 9/2022 of the 4th of April 2022: On the defining of the termination of pregnancy as a medical procedure and establishing a person's right to medical procedures.

BY THE GRACE OF GOD, WE MAXIMILIAN, PRINCE OF KAHARAGIA,

etc., etc., etc.,

RECOGNIZING that so long as it is not a matter of public health, a person has the right to autonomy over their own body and that medical decisions are a private matter between a person and their practitioner of medicine;

CONSIDERING Our trust in practitioners of medicine as the experts in their field, them knowing and understanding health and medicine to best assist their patients;

By virtue of Our Royal prerogative and Our especial grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion have willed and ordained to DECREE:

ARTICLE I: Termination of pregnancy is considered a medical procedure. The right to abortion is recognized as a human right and forced pregnancy is considered a crime against humanity.

ARTICLE II: No law shall restrict a person's right to medical procedures or care as determined appropriate by a recognized, legitimate, and authorized practitioner of medicine.

ARTICLE III: A person fleeing to Kaharagian territory from persecution due to a medical procedure shall be afforded full protections of a refugee.

ARTICLE IV: This decree shall take effect from the date of Our signature and promotion. We charge this decree's execution to all individuals having duly appoint authority to do so.
